The Mighty Miss Malone by Christopher Paul Curtis Copyright 2012

This book is historical fiction. It is not usually the type of book I choose to read, (I prefer fantasy) but I got it as a gift and I really loved it.

Deza Malone, her brother Jimmie, and their parents live together in the town of Gary Wisconsin until their father leaves to find work, saying that the rest of the family should stay home until he makes some money, because there are very few jobs in Gary, especially for black men like Mr. Malone. Then Deza, Jimmie, and their mother set out to look for him. One thing I liked in this book was that the story was told by Deza. This book takes place in 1936 when there was depression going on.

I think Deza is a very believable and lovable character. She loves to read and write, just like I do! I think this book tells about an important time in our history, when the black people had not yet been given American rights.

I would recommend this book to people who are at least 9. I think that you would probably like this book if you are interested in historical fiction or that time period.


There are several different ways to make a website that I might write about in a future article; but the method I am writing about today is a website called Weebly. Here's a link to Weebly: www.weebly.com. It's the website I made the Digerydoo website. In case you want to check it out, here's a link: www.digerydoomagazine.weebly.com. I have made several websites on Weebly and I going to tell you basically how it works. You need an account to make a website. It is required that you give your full name, email address, and make a password. You can make up to ten websites for free. You may be able to make more websites if you buy their paid version. In the paid version you can choose one of two plans; Pro or Starter. Pro cost 8\$ per month and includes special features such as HD audio and video, password protected page, the ability to take the .weebly part out of your web address, and more! The Starter plan has less special features but you can still take the .weebly part out of your web address. In the free and paid versions of Weebly you can add other people as editors to your website. That means they can edit and post things on your website. You can add pages or blog pages, where people can comment, in the 'pages' page at the top of the page.

Wow, that was a lot of pages in one sentence. Was that confusing?

Anyway-you can add elements such as paragraph or picture by dragging them onto your page from your toolbar on the left side of the page. When you are finished with your website click 'publish' and it will be on the web!




